THE CHOIR

Our choir sing at the 12.00 Mass on a Sunday and lead the music at major liturgical events in Advent/Christmas and Lent/Easter. New members are always welcome. A commitment would involve you being available for most / all of the above and to attend as regularly as possible, the choir rehearsal on a Thursday evening from 7.00pm to 9.00pm. The ability to read music is not essential. Music includes a full range of styles from Plainsong to contemporary idioms.

OUR CANTORS

The role of the Cantor is now very well established throughout the Church and we are looking for people to assume this role here in our Cathedral in Glasgow. It would involve you singing the Psalm and Gospel Acclamation and to assist the congregation in musical aspects of the liturgy. Full training will be given to develop you in this role. All you really need to do is to be able to sing and to have the confidence to do so on your own and to work as part of the Music Ministry for the greater glory of God.
