6.00pm - The Mass of the Lord's Supper

This Mass celebrates the institution of the Eucharist and Christ's eternal gift to the Church.

9.00pm - Night Prayer at the Altar of Repose

Good Friday, 18th April - Day of Fasting and Abstinence

10.00am – Morning Prayer

3.00pm - The Solemn Liturgy of the Passion of the Lord

The reading of the Passion, the Veneration of the Cross, and Holy Communion.

A collection will be taken up for the Holy Places.

6.00pm—Meditations on the Passion with Veneration of the Cross

Holy Saturday, 19th April

10.00am – Morning Prayer

9.00pm—The Easter Vigil

The Service of Light and the Liturgy of the Word are followed by the baptism and initiation of the Church's new members, who then join the whole assembly in the first Eucharist of Easter.

Easter Sunday, 20th April - Mass at 10.00am and 12noon only. No evening Mass.

Easter Monday, 21st April - Mass at 1.00pm. No evening Mass.

Tuesday 22nd April - Normal Mass schedule resumes.
